

Ancram Comp Plan Survey Due Date Extended to January 15

The Ancram Comprehensive Planning Committee has decided to send out one more post card reminder to all Ancram residents encouraging everyone who had not yet filled out and sent back the questionnaires to do so before January 15.

Over 25% of the Comprehensive Planning surveys, which were sent to Ancram residents and property owners in November, were returned by the December 7 return date, according to Ancram Comp Pan Committee Chair Art Bassin.

“We are very pleased with the return rate”, said Bassin. “The 400 surveys returned so far represent about 70% of the people who voted in the November election and represent almost 50% of the households in the Town of Ancram”.

Ancram had sent out a postcard in late November making people aware of the delays affecting the survey mailing, and volunteers had made phone calls to residents in December reminding everyone to send in the surveys.

“The Thanksgiving and Christmas holidays, with people on vacation and traveling to visit family and all have probably caused some of the surveys to get overlooked and not returned yet”, commented Bassin. “We think it’s important to ask one more time for people to send back the surveys, so we are sending out this final reminder post card”.

Ancram’s Comp Plan surveys had been delayed in the Thanksgiving week mail, and arrived in Ancram homes about a week later than expected, during the last week of November.
