

Ancram Comp Plan Surveys Delayed

The Ancram Comprehensive Planning survey questionnaires were delivered to the Albany post office on Friday November 16 for delivery the following week. But as of Saturday, November 24, no surveys had arrived in the mail.

Ancram Comp Plan Committee Chair Art Bassin is puzzled by the delay. “We do not know if the surveys are lost or are just going to arrive a week late because of the very heavy mail schedule of Thanksgiving week” said Bassin. “We plan to see if they turn up this week, by the end of November, before we declare them lost and reprint and re-mail them”.

The surveys had originally been due to be completed and returned by Monday, November 26, but since no one has yet received any surveys yet, that return date is no longer valid. “If the surveys turn up before the end of November, we will ask that people return them By December 7”, Bassin said.

The Ancram Comp Plan Committee will decide by the end of November if it needs to reprint and re-mail the surveys. Whatever the decision, a post card will be mailed to all 1600 people on the survey mailing list to tell them what has happened and what the new survey return date is.
