

Eastern States Drillers Volunteers to Assist Ancram Residents

Ancram, November 16, 2007 – Eastern States Well Drillers, responsible for drilling many of the wells in the Ancram area, has offered to help residents complete the Ancram well water questionnaire, which is part of the Ancram Comprehensive Plan survey package sent out on November 16.

Anyone needing information on the depth of their wells and casings, and the flow rate of their wells, should contact Eastern States representative Ken Burdick at 518-325-4679, or at ken.eswd@fairpoint.net. Eastern States has well data filed by the name of the owners of each property when the well was drilled.

Ancram residents are encouraged to call Eastern to find out if they can provide the information needed to complete the well water survey. If Eastern did not drill your well, well data may be available from whichever well drilling firm did your well, or from the home inspection report done at the time the home was purchased.

The Ancram Comprehensive Planning Committee mailed two surveys -- one a 7 page general survey and one single page well water survey -- to over 1600 residents, property owners and businesses on Friday, November 16. The surveys are due back by November 26, and should be filled out by every individual over the age of 18 in the Town of Ancram.

According to Ancram Comp Plan Committee Chair Art Bassin, the surveys should arrive by Tuesday November 20. “If you do not get the surveys by the end of the week” said Bassin, “call me at 329-0921 or email me at abassin@aol.com and I will make sure we get one to you.”
